Analysis of judicial decisions

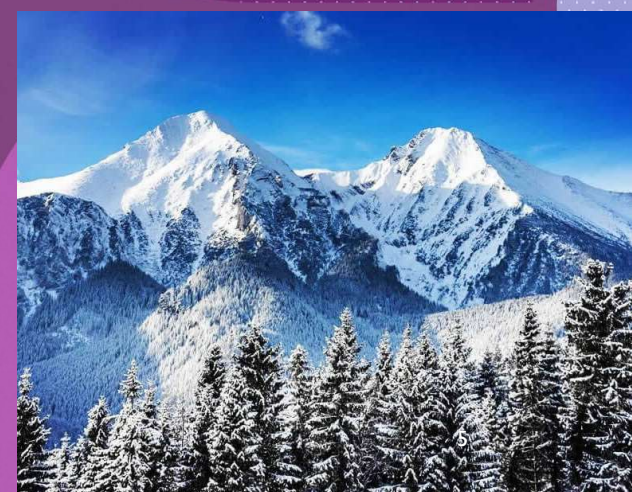
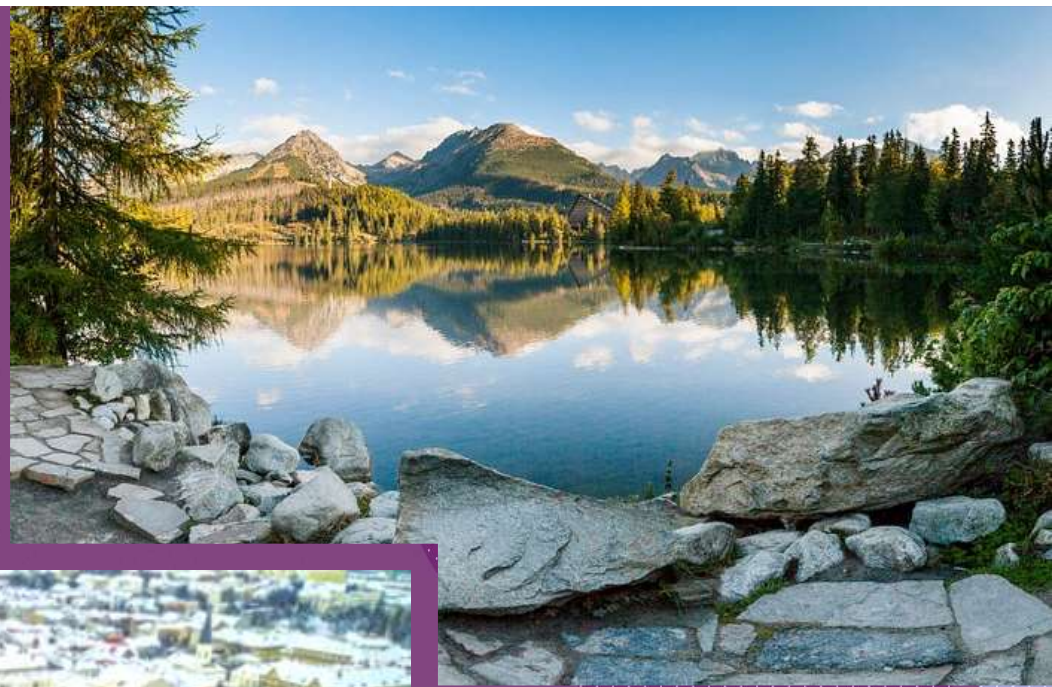
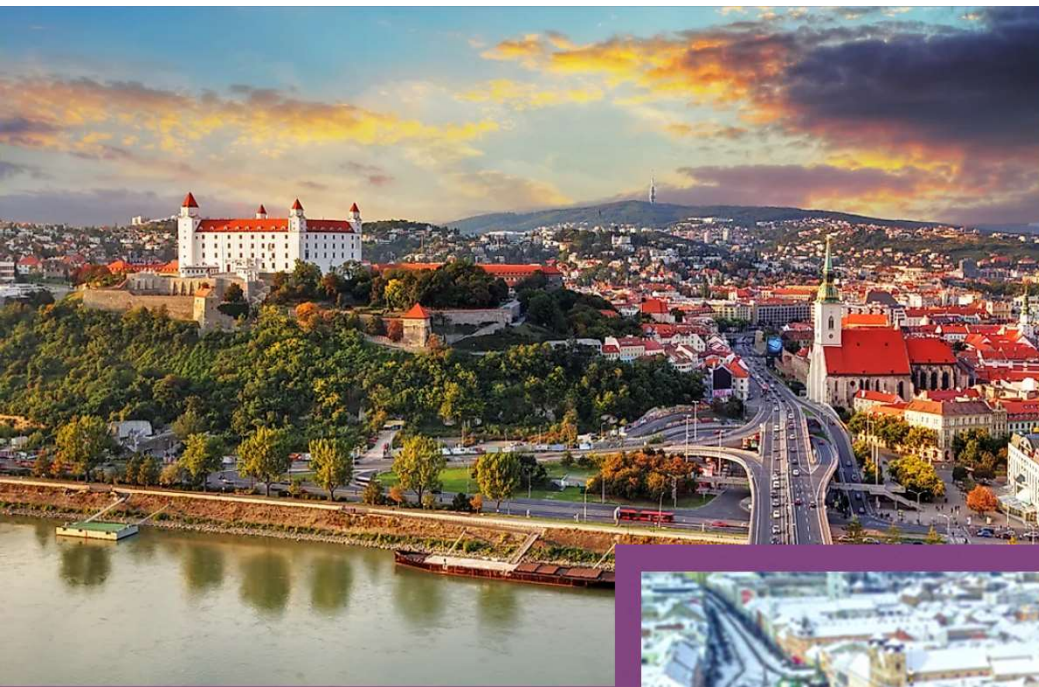
- Judicial decisions in common law v. continental law
- Public availability of judicial decisions, incl. decisions of lower courts
- Research results:
 - a) uniform application of the law by national courts
 - b) decisions deviating from the accepted interpretation of the law
 - c) successful preparation for the trial

Analysis of digital evidence

- quantitative and qualitative data analysis of evidence produced in judicial proceedings
- research objectives:
 - a) how courts interpret digital evidence
 - b) whether courts understand the relevant technical aspects of digital evidence
 - c) which evidence influences the judge's decision
 - d) what relations exist between different types of evidence
 - e) how is the discretionary weighing of evidence principle and other legal principles applied in court proceedings
 - f) ...
